- Health Workforce capacitation increased funding in Southeast Asia and Guatemala to look at issues
  with COVID vaccination and health workforce needs (vaccine allocation and rollout, reporting, vaccine
  usage safety throughout supply chain), integration of COVID vaccine through pediatrics and family
  planning
- Partnership with NursingNow challenge released survey in partnership with Coventry to see impacts of identity

- Webinar series on Year of the Nurse & Midwife and on nursing workforce, planning stages on webinars for midwives
- Midwifery Network side event at Botswana conference in planning stages with Johns Hopkins

## SEARO: Dr. Vathsala Sadan India

- Survey to midwives of India
- Leadership for Change project in collaboration with ICM, projects planned for 5 months ex: integration of education and nursing practice, will have update early March
- Disaster Nursing Network next meeting February 22, conference in May
- Capacity building factory in collaboration with NFBA for midwife redevelopment in India
- 3<sup>rd</sup> wave of COVID since January with less severity, mostly at-home quarantine with mild symptoms, minimal issues with hospitalization & mortality, starting with booster doses (vaccination camp every Sunday)
- Hematology conference planned for September
